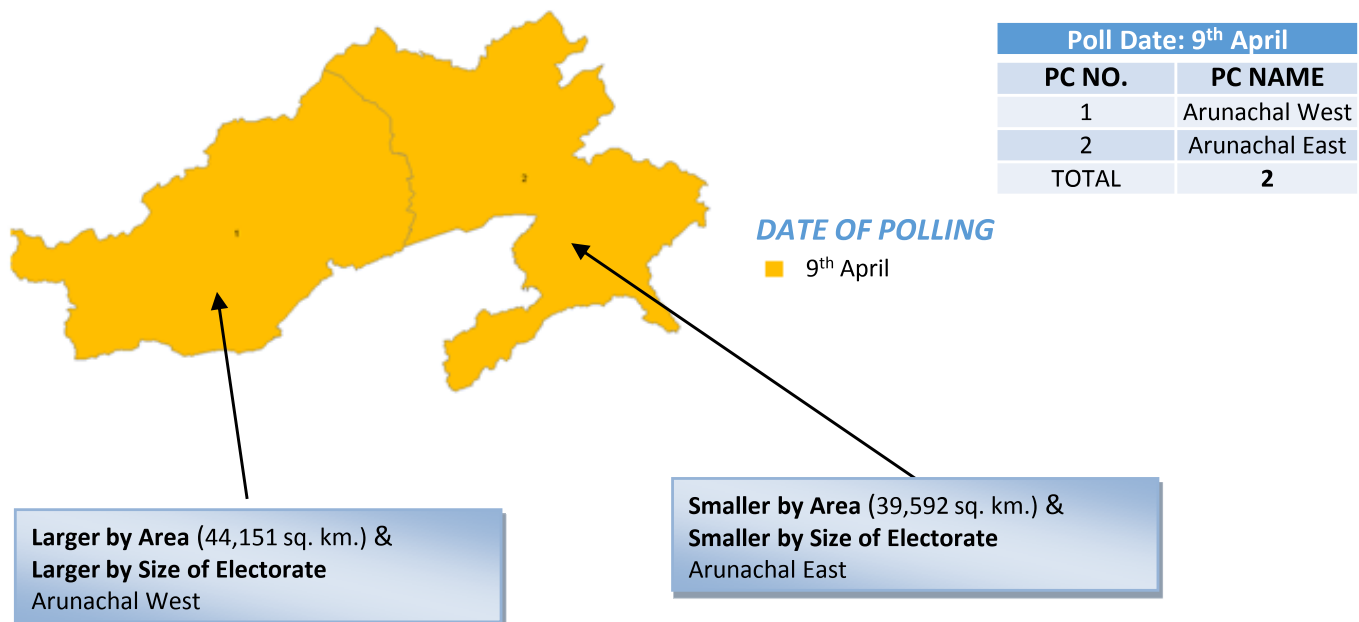


# FACT SHEET ON ARUNACHAL PRADESH

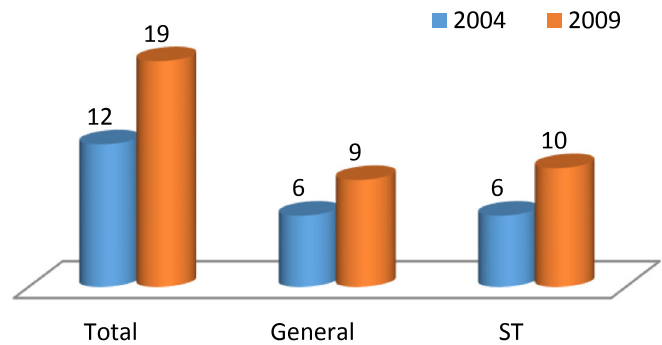

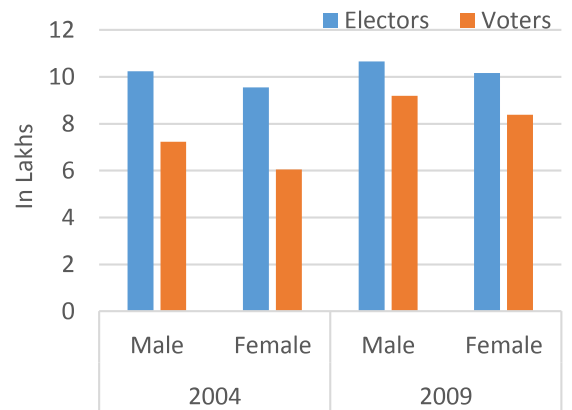

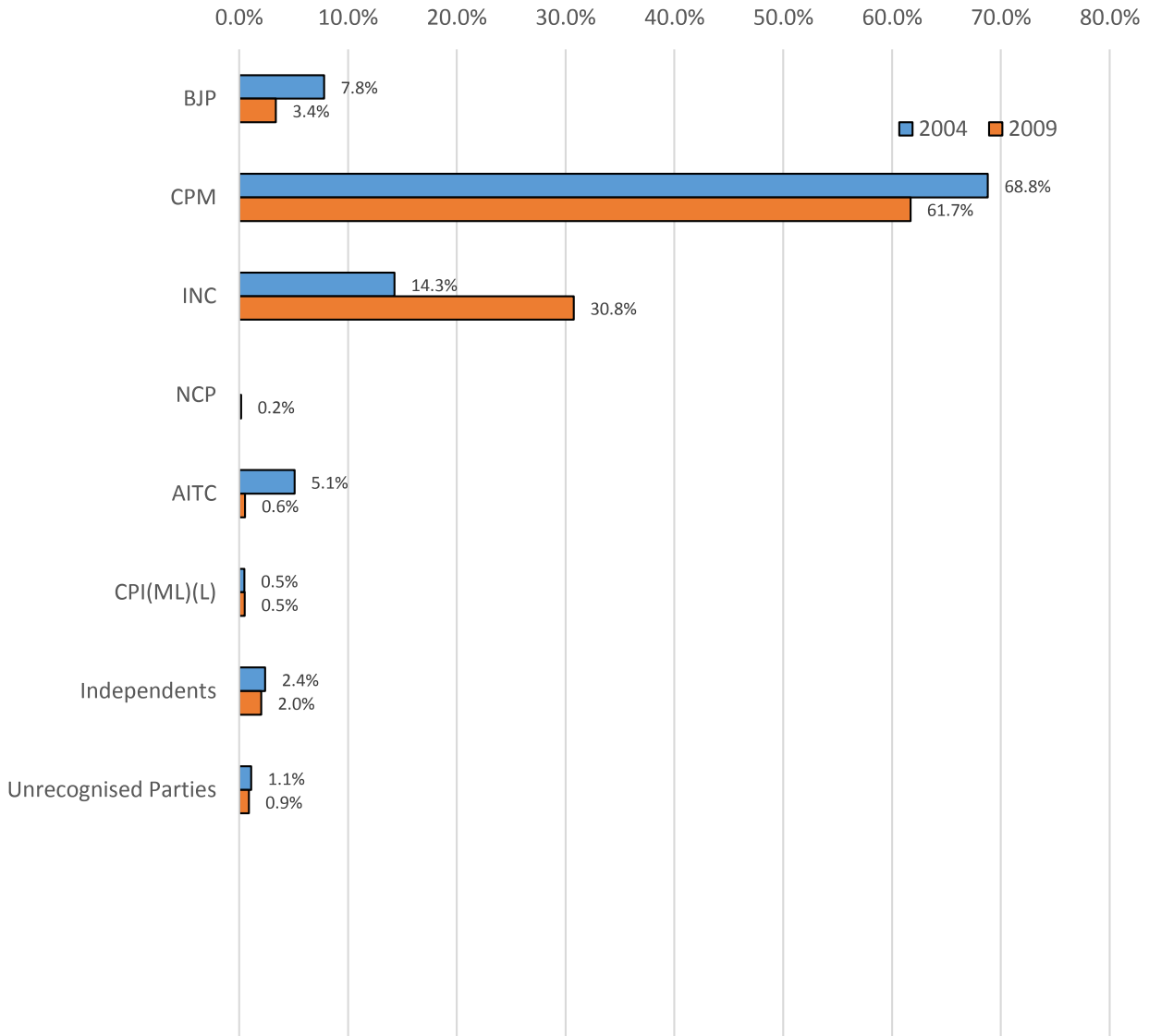
