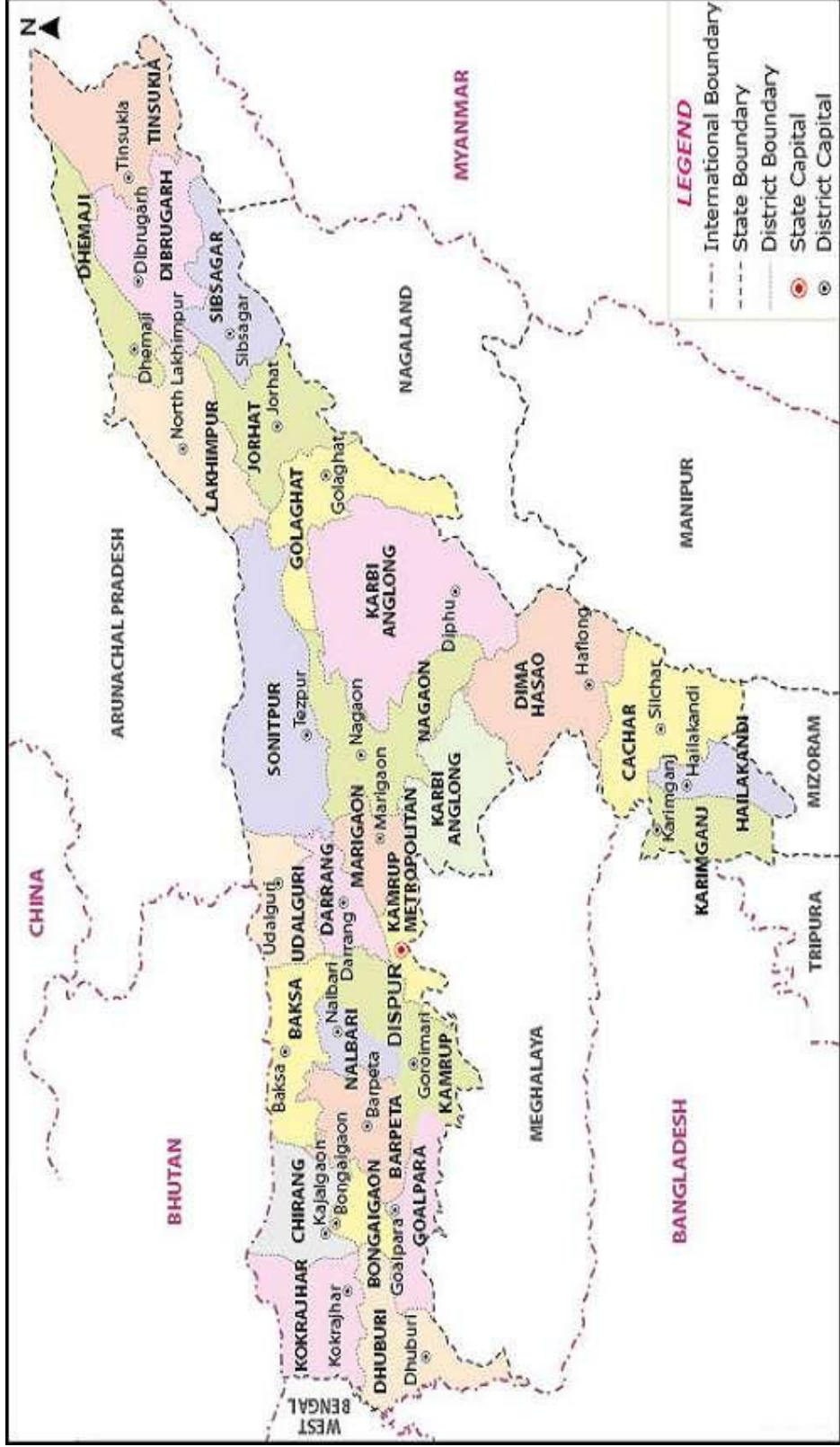

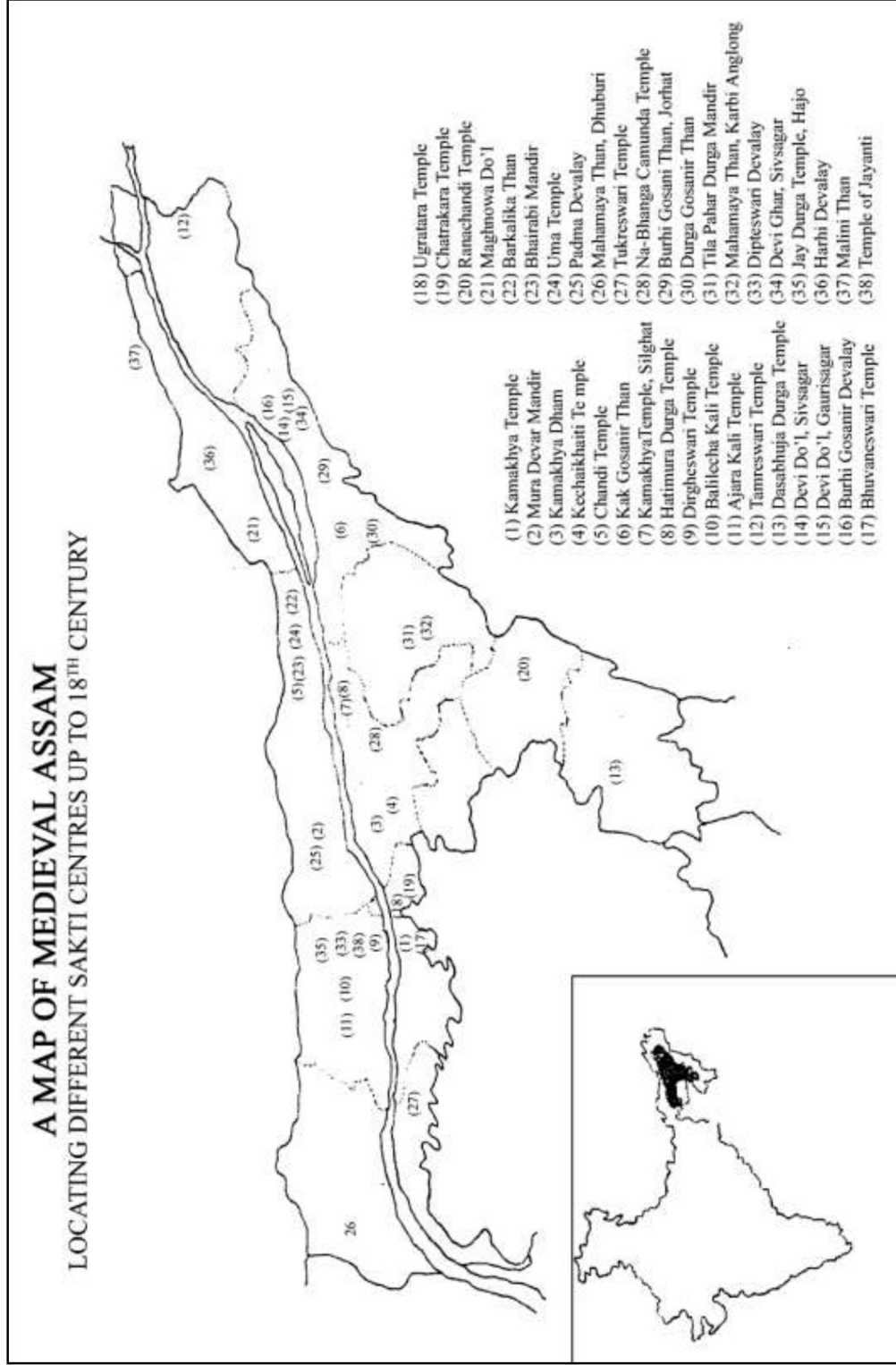

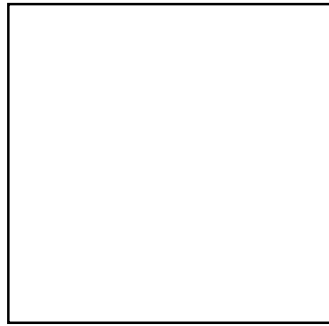

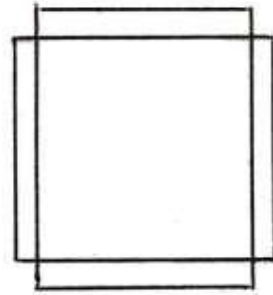


Ratha Plans of the Temples

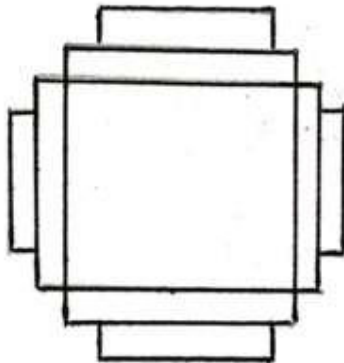
a. Square



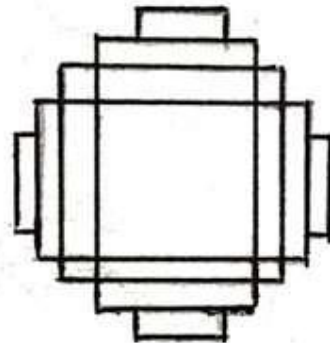
b. *Triratha*



c. *Pancharatha*

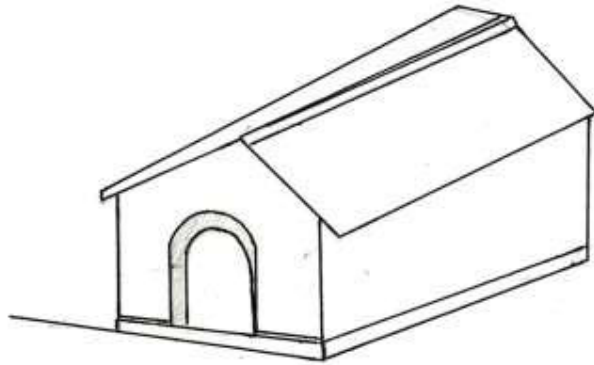


d. *Saptaratha*

b. Bengal hut type

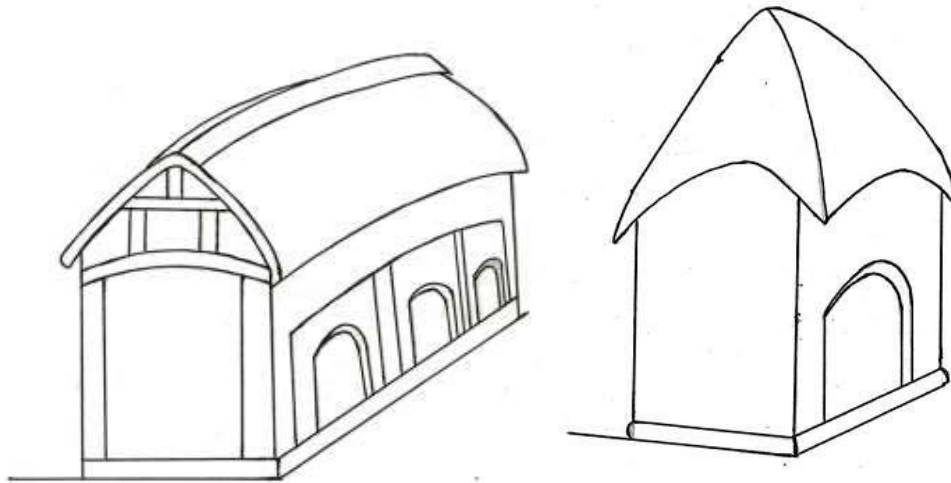
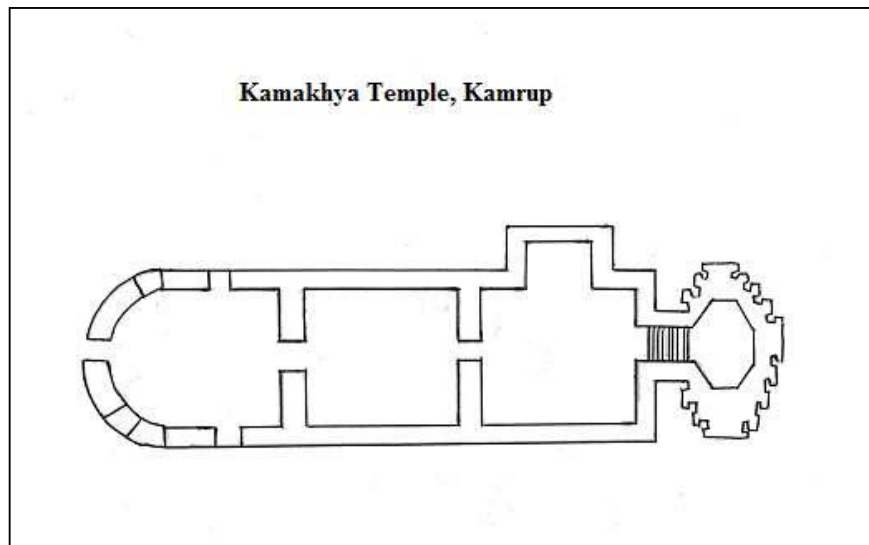
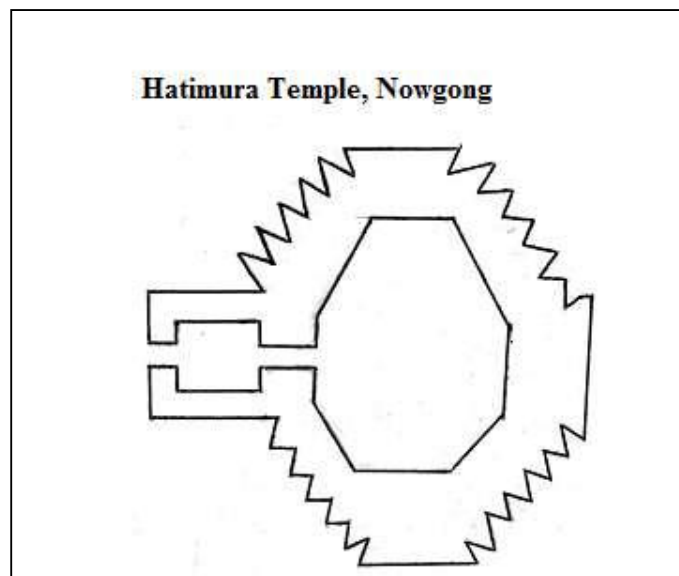

Maghnowa Do'l, Lakhimpur

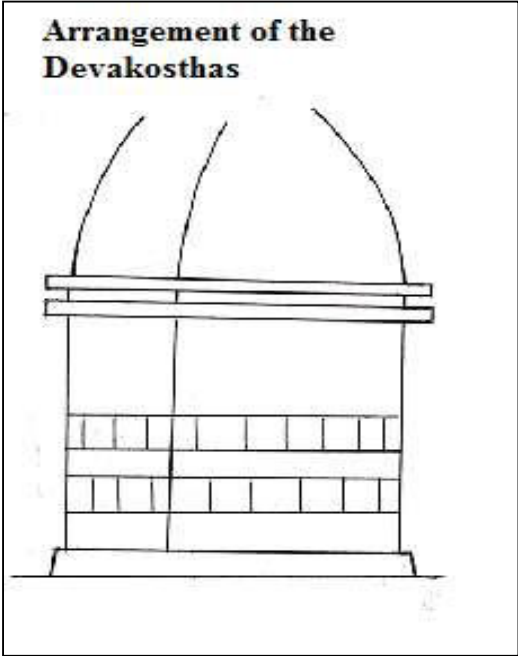
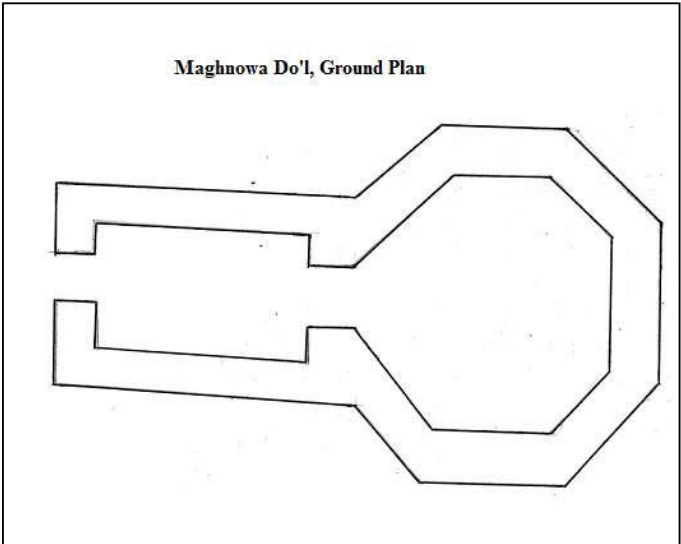
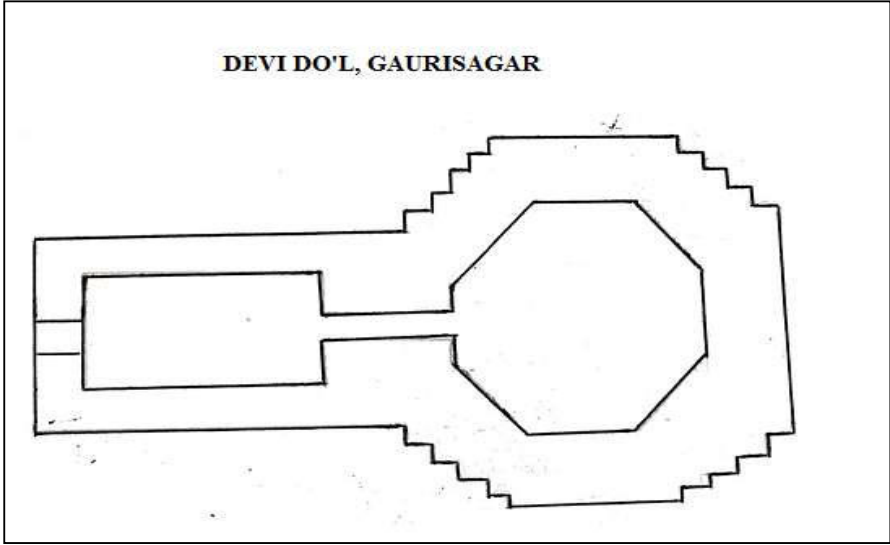
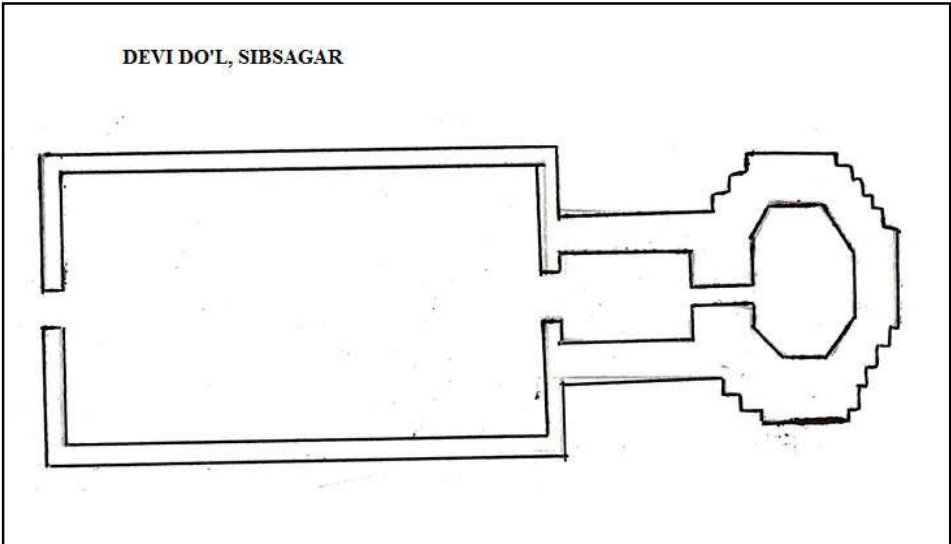
