#### **PREFACE**

The dissertation entitled 'A dichotomic interpretation of the sacrifices of Rājasūya, Vājapeya and Aśvamedha: their ritualistic and monarchial strata with reference to the Satapatha Brāhmana' attempts to take up a study of the sacrifices mentioned in the title to search the monarchial elevation of the sacrifices veiled under the ritualistic performances as found in the Satapatha Brāhmaṇa of the Vājasaneyī Samhitā. The Brāhmana texts chiefly enlighten us with the course of ritualistic activities. The Brāhmanas are the oldest source from which a comprehensive description of all the sacrificial ceremonies can be obtained. The most important and voluminous Satapatha Brāhmana is attached to Śukla Yajurveda of Mādhyandina recension, where we get detail information of all forms of sacrifices. The objective of the research work is to find out the ritualistic and monarchial importance (dichotomic strata) of the Rājasūya, Vājapeya and the Aśvamedha sacrifice.

This dissertation paper is prepared with a survey of the Vedic texts-the Rgveda, the Yajurveda, the Sāmaveda, the Atharvaveda, the Aitareya Brāhmaṇa, the Taittirīya Brāhmaṇa, the Gopatha Brāhmaṇa, the Śatapatha Brāhmaṇa, the Tāṇḍya Mahā Brāhmaṇa, the Śankhyāyaṇa Brāhmaṇa and the Śrauta Sūtras of different Vedas. The Śatapatha

Brāhmaṇa ed. by Maitreyee Deshpande, New Bharatiya Book Corporation, Delhi-2008, remained the main source of transliteration.

The present work is divided in to seven chapters. The first chapter is an introductory chapter, where a discussion is made on the importance of the Veda, Brāhmana, its division and subdivision and so on. In the second chapter a general survey is prepared on the sacrifices of the Satapatha Brāhmaṇa. Various sacrificial matters and the importance of sacrifice are also discussed in this chapter. The third chapter deals with the special position and significance of the sacrifices having political importance. The subject matter of the fourth chapter is the major sacrifices of the Satapatha Brāhmaṇa -Rājasūya, Vājapeya and Aśvamedha and its relation to monarchy in Ancient time. In the fifth chapter, the minor sacrifices of the Satapatha Brāhmaṇa (Puruṣamedha, Sarvamedha, Agnicayana, Cāturmāsya and Sautrāmanī) are discussed with its royal significance. The sixth chapter is on the dichotomic interpretation of the major and minor sacrifices of the Satapatha Brāhmana. Finally, the thesis resumes to its concluding observation that the political genesis of ancient India was impregnated in these sacrifices. A derivative interpretation of the details of the rituals of these sacrifices had a dichotomic approach which contributed a lot in bringing up in to shape or come in to existence of monarchy in ancient India.
