

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

<i>'Beel' and 'Haor'</i>	:	High hills and low land
<i>Beldar</i>	:	Arranger of bricks inside the kiln
<i>Bhiga</i>	:	A land measure equivalent to one-third of an acre.
<i>Chowkidar</i>	:	Guard
<i>Jalaidar</i>	:	Fireman
<i>Khuraki</i>	:	An amount of wages paid to meet the daily needs of the workers
<i>Munim/Munshi</i>	:	Accountant
<i>Nikasi</i>	:	One who remove the fired bricks from the kiln and arrange them in stacks according to grades/quality of bricks.
<i>Pathera</i>	:	Moulder
<i>Puthai</i>	:	The process of making the clay
<i>Reja</i>	:	Women engaged in loading and unloading of bricks
<i>Rapaswale</i>	:	One who arranges and dismantles the layer of soil from the arranged bricks before and after they are burnt in the kiln
<i>Sardar</i>	:	Contractor
<i>Tilla</i>	:	A hillock
